



## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Proposed Amendments to Rule 42, Permit Fees**

The Air Pollution Control Board will meet to consider the adoption of proposed amendments to Rule 42. The revision would increase permit renewal fees by 3.5 percent, effective July 1, 2019. For permit holders paying the minimum fee, this proposal will result in an increase of \$21.00 per year. The California Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers has increased 3.85 percent since the last time this rule was amended in 2018.

District operations are funded by state and federal grants, automobile registration fees, and fees charged to sources of air pollution. The District receives no property tax revenue or Ventura County general fund revenue. The fee increase is necessary to offset rising expenses.
