

# VENTURA COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

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## PUBLIC WORKSHOP

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The Ventura County Air Pollution Control District (“District”) will hold a Public Workshop to discuss proposed amendments to **Rule 42 – Permit Fees**. The proposed revisions will update rule language for clarity and readability, increase the permit processing fee deposit to streamline invoice payments, and increase renewal fee rates by 5 percent or greater, effective July 1, 2025, to recover the District’s operating expenses and to rectify deficiencies caused by rounding. For permit holders paying the minimum renewal fee, this proposal will result in an increase of \$37 for fiscal year 2025-2026. District operations are funded by state and federal grants, automobile registration fees, and fees charged to sources of air pollution. The District receives no property tax revenue or Ventura County general fund revenue.

The public is encouraged to attend and provide input to the District. The Public Workshop will occur virtually and in person at the following time and location:
