Authorization to Approve Grant Funding Requests for 32 New Agricultural SUBJECT: Air Quality Projects and Two (2) Electric Charging Infrastructure Projects Under the Carl Moyer Memorial Air Quality Standards Attainment Program Totaling \$3,848,889 (Recommendation #36 Requires Six Affirmative Votes)

District staff requests your Board's approval and modification of the District's expense and revenue appropriations for the above-recommended projects.

STATEMENT OF MATTER FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION:

Background

The Carl Moyer Memorial Air Quality Standards Attainment Program (Carl Moyer Program, Health & Safety Code §44275 et seq.)¹ provides monetary incentives through local air pollution control districts to replace older, heavy-duty diesel equipment with newer, lower-emission equipment. Permanent destruction of the older, high-emissions equipment is required as part of the program.

Senate Bill 513 (SB 513, Beall, 2015) provided new opportunities to update the Carl Moyer Program. In response to SB 513, CARB updated the Carl Moyer Program Guidelines in 2017 to adjust the cost-effectiveness limits, increase opportunities for co-funding with other incentives, and allow infrastructure projects. Infrastructure projects must be used to fuel or power covered sources as defined by Health and Safety Code section 44275(a)(7) including, but not limited to, on-road, off-road, agricultural and marine vessel emission sources. Infrastructure projects do not require destruction of older, higher-polluting equipment and are not required to meet a cost-effectiveness threshold.

¹ The program is named after the late Dr. Carl Moyer in recognition of his work in the air quality field and his efforts in establishing the program.

In April 2023, the District advertised the availability of Carl Moyer grant funds by posting the announcement on its website, by emailing the announcement to interested parties and organizations, and by contacting local equipment dealers and installers who spread the word to their customers and potential grant applicants. The deadline for submitting applications was June 23, 2023. The District received applications for grant funding to replace 181 pieces of diesel agricultural equipment and install 11 charging stations. District staff evaluated the eligibility of each Carl Moyer grant application and related piece of equipment, as well as the costs and benefits of the newer and cleaner equipment. Staff then ranked each eligible piece of equipment against the others in terms of dollars per ton of air pollutants reduced. The most cost-effective projects are proposed for funding.

This year marks the twenty-fifth year the District has administered a local Carl Moyer grant program. The grants previously approved by your Board and the instant proposed grants are summarized in the table below.

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Current Proposal

Based on District staff analysis of all Carl Moyer Program agricultural replacement and infrastructure applications and corresponding equipment, we recommend your Board approve a total of \$3,848,889 in funding to support the 32 agricultural replacement and two (2) infrastructure projects described in Attachment 1 and as set forth in Recommended Actions 1 through 34 above. The total cost of the funded projects, including each applicant's cost share, is \$6,249,601.

The proposed projects result in a total projected emission reduction of 22.9 tons per year of ozone precursors, 1.7 tons per year of diesel particulate matter, and 309 metric tonnes of carbon dioxide (a greenhouse gas) per year.

Staff will administer the grant agreements and ensure contract requirements are met before making grant payments. The APCO requests authorization to make any necessary minor administrative changes to the grant agreements subject to County Counsel review and approval.
